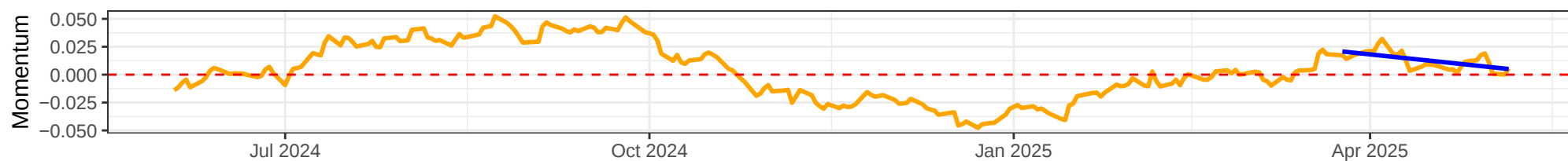
BITCOIN versus US Dollar
